Spay and Neuter Aftercare for Rabbits

Your Rabbit has undergone anesthesia today and therefore their behavior may be altered for the evening. For example, your rabbit may be wobbly, irritable, tired, and have glossy eyes. Listed below are some helpful tips to make tonight and your rabbits recover more pleasant.

- ✚ Please make sure that your rabbit has plenty of food and water available, try to get your bunny to eat some of their favorite treats when they arrive home. If your rabbit has not eating or drinking within 12 hours please contact our office.
- ✚ Try to keep your rabbit away from other pets and small children for the first 24 hours.
- ✚ Discourage exercise and play for the next 10 days.
- ✚ Do not allow your rabbit to lick or chew at the incision. If licking occurs please call our office to get additional pain medication.
- ✚ No bathing for 14 days. You may use a damp washcloth if your rabbit needs to be cleaned.
- ✚ Watch the incision for any signs of infection. Signs of infection can include swelling, redness, discharge (blood or pus). If you have any questions regarding your rabbits recovery please call our office.
- ✚ We use absorbable sutures so no need to bring your rabbit back unless you have any questions.
- ✚ Do not use any type of alcohol or peroxide to clean your rabbit's incision, please call our office if you have questions.

Your pet's recovery is very important to us, complications from routine spay and neuter surgeries are rare, however if you have any questions or concerns please contact our office immediately so that we may provide you with assisting you pet with a smooth recovery.
