### **Feral Cat Aftercare Instructions**

Some Cats may be drowsy from anesthesia for up to 24 hours following surgery. Please release cats when they are fully awake for some this may take a full 24 hours. Otherwise **release cats at 10pm** that evening or the following morning. Before releasing the cat from the trap please set up the cat's food & water. There is no need to slip food into the trap!

Please monitor the cat periodically if you are leaving cat in trap overnight. Cats are not able to regulate body temperature very well after surgery. It is best to keep the cat indoors or out of the direct sunlight. If you must keep cat outside please place a wet towel and place over trap. If you have several trapped cats you may put traps close together to keep warm during winter months.

Please watch for the following:

Excessive Bleeding  
Cats that are not fully awake by 6pm  
Very slow or Very fast Breathing
